Artist statements must be a maximum of 500 characters and spaces.</p>	<p>Middle School & High School, Grades 6-12 Categories (full descriptions)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2D: Drawing, Graphic Design, Illustration, Mixed Media, Painting, Photography, Printmaking • 3D: Architecture, Ceramics, Glass, Fashion & Accessories, Industrial Design, Sculpture • Time Based Media: Film/Video, Animation • <u>Wave Awards</u>: Speciality Award Entries- artwork and accompanying artist statement: Self-Portrait, Social Justice and Abstract/Experimental artworks

See RIDE Directory for list of eligible schools. • Homeschooled students may enter • Limit 6 entries per teacher • Limit 2 entries <i>per student</i>, with a maximum of 6 entries per teacher • Limit 2 entries per student teacher (submissions are separate from, but must be approved by, cooperating teacher)
